CHRISTMAS in BEANTOWN

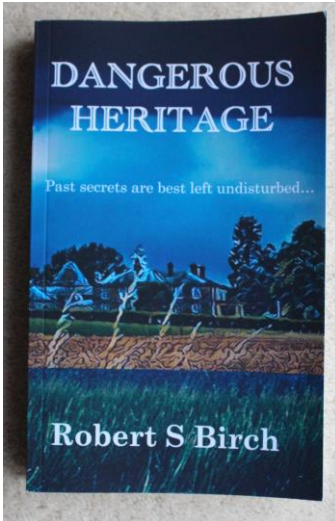
